Annexe 3 — M15+ programme

Manifesta 15+ is a programme that enhances the cultural offerings of the participating municipalities in Manifesta 15 Barcelona Metropolitana. Led by local Artistic Representatives, it highlights the region's cultural richness through diverse activities such as exhibitions, festivals, screenings, discussions, concerts and tours.

The Manifesta 15+ programme is multidisciplinary and varies widely across the eleven municipalities of the metropolitan region. Some cities, such as Sabadell, Badalona, Terrassa and Cornellà de Llobregat have focused their Manifesta 15+ proposals around common themes that run throughout the biennial. Others, like Sant Cugat del Vallès, Santa Coloma de Gramenet, Granollers and L'Hospitalet have emphasised strong community engagement. Meanwhile, municipalities such as El Prat de Llobregat, Mataró and Sant Adrià de Besòs have organised activities that highlight their industrial, historical and natural heritage. Badalona **Épica La Fura dels Baus Foundation** **(Fundació Èpica la Fura dels Baus)**

Épica La Fura dels Baus Foundation is a centre for creation and research in advanced arts that fosters horizontal collaboration between humanities, science, technology and society. This space is dedicated to exploring and integrating innovative practices and concepts, encouraging interdisciplinary approaches that bridge these diverse fields. By facilitating cooperative projects and dialogues, the centre aims to advance knowledge and creativity at the intersection of art, science and technology, while also addressing contemporary societal issues.

Cornellà de Llobregat **Concèntrica Factory**

The Concèntrica Factory is a dynamic space where cinematic, visual and contemporary arts converge to explore new forms of experimentation, expression, and representation from a local cultural perspective. It serves as an incubator for innovative artistic projects that blend disciplines and languages, offering a cutting-edge view of the world. This venue is housed in a former building of the legendary Siemens factory, which was inaugurated in 1910. This factory was one of Catalonia's main industrial centres, spanning four generations and becoming a significant transgenerational landmark.

Sabadell **L'Estruch. Factory for the production and promotion of live arts**

L'Estruch is a centre for the production and promotion of live arts, hosting creative residencies in dance, circus, performance and new stage formats. The common thread across all its activities is contemporary creation.

Granollers **Roca Umbert. Arts Factory (Roca Umbert. Fàbrica de les arts)**

A cultural space in constant transformation, dedicated to creative processes, artistic training and dialogue between the arts, it is one of the main venues for Manifesta 15 Barcelona Metropolitana and will also host the Panòramic Festival as part of the Manifesta 15+ programme.

Mataró **Mataró Museum. Can Marfà Gènere de Punt**

Can Marfà is the exhibition space of the Mataró Museum dedicated to the knitwear industry, an industrial activity that has significantly shaped the city's uniqueness and identity. It is located in one of the buildings of the former Marfà factory, which was the most important knitwear manufacturer in Spain before 1936.

Santa Coloma de Gramenet **Can Sisteré Contemporary Art Center**

The Can Sisteré Cultural Centre promotes a variety of contemporary art forms, aiming to bring them closer to the public and to familiarise the residents of Santa Coloma with emerging visual and plastic arts. It also aspires to be a cultural space for community engagement, debate and reflection, serving as a resource for information, learning, awareness and enjoyment for the local citizens.

Terrassa **Muncunill Exhibition Room (Sala Muncunill)**

La Sala Muncunill was inaugurated in 1986 and is located within one of the city's unique buildings, the Vapor Amat, a former dye factory. It is one of the exhibition spaces in the city dedicated to contemporary artistic practices, along with the Casa Soler i Palet.

L'Hospitalet **Tecla Sala Art Centre (Centre d'Art Tecla Sala)**

The Tecla Sala Art Centre is a landmark facility in the city, housing the Art Centre, the Central Library, the Arranz-Bravo Foundation, the TPK – Pubilla Cases Workshop and L'Hospitalet Study Centre (CEL'H).

El Prat de Llobregat **Espigoladors Foundation (Local dels Espigoladors)**

The Espigoladors Foundation is a non-profit organisation dedicated to combating food waste and loss while empowering individuals at risk of social exclusion through transformative, participatory, inclusive and sustainable methods.

Sant Adrià de Besòs **Catalan Immigration History Museum (MhiC)**

The Masia de Can Serra, located in Sant Adrià de Besòs, houses the Catalan Immigration History Museum (MhiC), a project that features a permanent exhibition and a temporary exhibition hall. The exhibition space also offers an annual programme that explores themes of migration and intercultural dialogue, incorporating cultural activities related to exhibitions and educational initiatives.

Manifesta 15 Barcelona Metropolitana 2024 is co-initiated by the Municipality of Barcelona and the International Foundation Manifesta. Additional public partners are the Barcelona Provincial Council, the Government of Catalonia and the Ministry of Culture and Sport of Spain.
